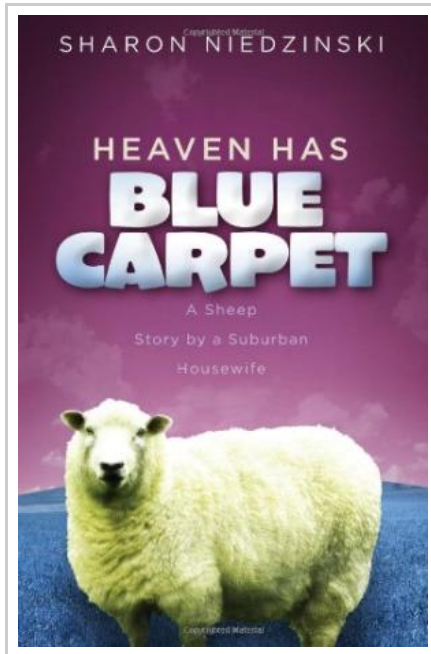




Heaven Has Blue Carpet: A Sheep Story by a Suburban Housewife
