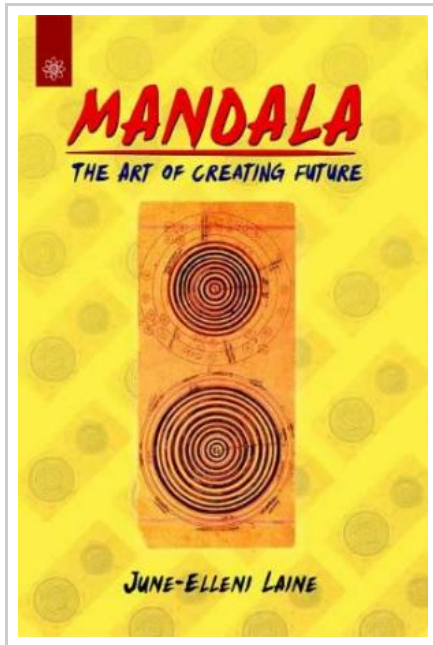




Mandala: The Art of Creating Future
