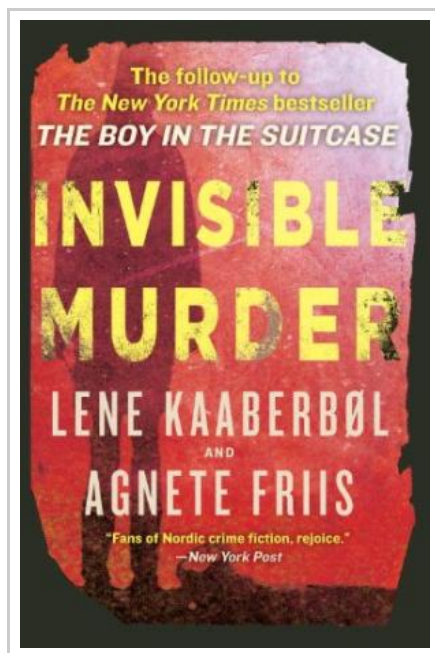




Invisible Murder

This second installment of Lene Kaaberbøl and Agnete Friis's series starring Red Cross nurse Nina Borg following their 2011 New York Times bestseller *The Boy in the Suitcase* finds the nurse putting her life and family on the line when she tries to treat a group of Hungarian Gypsies who are living illegally in a Copenhagen garage. What are they hiding, and what is making them so sick? Nina is about to learn how high the stakes are among these desperate people.
